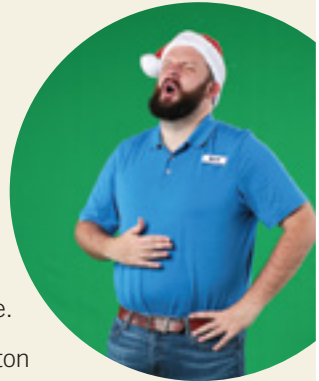

Cheese Crackers

1 1/2 cups self-rising flour

3 cups sharp cheddar cheese, grated

1/2 cups margarine, melted

2 1/2 cups potato chips, plain

4 teaspoons hot sauce (optional)
