Sausage Alfredo

PREPARE pasta according to package directions; drain and set aside.

SAUTE sausage in a large skillet over medium-high heat for 5 minutes, turning occasionally.

ADD cream and cajun seasoning; bring to a boil. Reduce heat; simmer gently for 3-4 minutes or until mixture begins to thicken. Remove from heat, stir in Parmesan cheese. Add pasta to sauce and toss.

Cook's Tip: For added fresh flavor, add 1 cup frozen green peas in last 3-4 minutes of cooking pasta. Continue as directed.

Severe Weather Safety from Atlanta Gas Light (AGL)

- Know the location of your gas meter.
- Leave your gas meter on to maintain proper pressure in the gas piping within your home or businesses and to prevent water from entering the lines should flooding occur. Most gas appliances have safety valves that shut off the flow of gas automatically if the pilot light goes out.
- Only AGL or emergency personnel should turn the natural gas valve off. In cases of severe lightning, you may want to unplug natural gas appliances to avoid possible electrical damage.
- If flooding occurs at a residence or business and the gas appliances are or have been submerged under water, do not try to operate the appliances.
- During clean up and repair after a storm avoid causing damage to the gas lines by calling 811 before digging. This also pertains to removing downed trees as they can become entangled with natural gas lines.
- Report a natural gas emergency to the AGL 24-hour emergency response line at 877.427.4321.

ATTENTION: Annual DDDC recalculation goes into effect Sept. 1

Factored into the base charge on your gas bill, the Dedicated Design Day Capacity Charge (DDDC) covers common costs of delivering gas to your home. This charge is based on the individual customer's demand on the pipeline system during the coldest day of the year. This method is used to allocate each customer's share of the total cost of the delivery system.

Each year, Atlanta Gas Light Company (AGL) recalculates DDDC for every customer account to ensure the data represents the most recent usage patterns. Recalculation takes place in August and will go into effect for billing after Sept. 1, 2016.
