Ricotta Cake

- 1 box butter-flavored cake mix
- 2 lbs. ricotta cheese
- 4 eggs
- 1 cup sugar
- 1 teaspoon vanilla
- powdered sugar, optional

Garnish with fresh sliced strawberries and a sprinkle of powdered sugar.



Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Prepare cake mix according to directions. Pour cake batter into a greased 9-by-13-inch pan. Next, beat together ricotta cheese, eggs, sugar and vanilla; then pour over batter. Bake for one hour. Test with a toothpick. Cool in pan, then sprinkle with powdered sugar.

3 Ways to Prevent a Gas Leak

Gas leaks are frightening and dangerous; knowing how to prevent one is imperative. Below are a few examples of how to avoid a gas leak. If you smell natural gas with its rotten egg odor, hear a hissing or blowing sound, or have dead or discolored vegetation in otherwise green areas, leave the area immediately. As you leave, avoid anything that may cause a spark such as lighters, matches, cigarettes, flashlights, light switches and telephones. Wait until you are a safe distance away and then call 1-877-427-4321.



INSPECTIONS

Schedule routine inspections with a licensed plumber to ensure safety and give you peace of mind.



NATURAL GAS FLAME

A steady blue flame indicates that pilot lights and burners are operating properly.



VENTILATION

Make sure to keep all areas around appliances and equipment clean and unblocked to allow the proper air flow.
