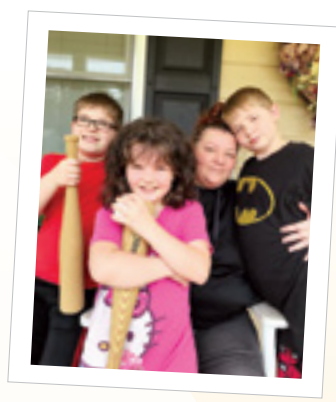
Offers a Helping Hand to Neighbors in Need

- HEAT has distributed more than \$24 million in energy assistance to over 100,000 families since its beginning in 1983.
- HEAT provided \$785,000 in energy assistance last winter. More than 5,400 individuals were assisted.
- Originally established by Atlanta Gas Light Company in 1983, HEAT is the oldest statewide fuel fund program in Georgia.
- Eighty cents out of every \$1 donated to HEAT goes directly to help families in need.
- One in five Georgia households will struggle to pay their heating bills this winter. That's 20 percent of our neighbors.
- Average income of households assisted by HEAT during winter 2017-2018 was \$9,960.

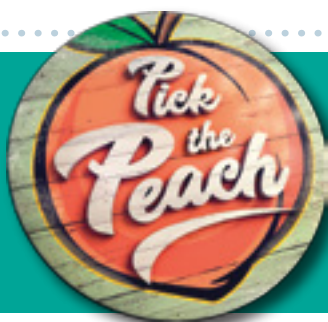
