Preheat oven to 375 degrees F. Coat a 2-quart casserole dish with nonstick spray. Put rice, cream soup, soup mix, water and peas in casserole dish and mix with spoon or whisk. Add chicken pieces and stir together. Cover and bake one hour or until the rice has absorbed water and chicken is cooked through.
