Lower Your Winter Energy Bill

If you want to save on your natural gas bill this winter, now is the time to take proactive steps. Try some of these hacks to use less energy and save money without sacrificing comfort.

TURN DOWN THE THERMOSTAT. Set your thermostat to 68 degrees in the daytime and 65 degrees when everyone is sleeping. Every degree you lower your thermostat below 70 can save 1% to 3% on heating costs.

FLIP THE FAN SWITCH. When you turn on the heat, remember to adjust the setting on your ceiling fan so the blades spin clockwise. This forces the hot air that rises to the ceiling down and into the room.

TURN DOWN THE TANK. Set your natural gas water heater temperature at 120 degrees. Every 10-degree increase above that wastes 3% to 5% on water heating costs. If your water heater is located in the garage, basement or other non-insulated space, wrap the tank in a water heater blanket to prevent heat loss.

LOCK IN A RATE. One of the easiest ways to save money on your natural gas bill is to lock in the rate you pay to Walton Gas. Though Walton Gas is typically one of Georgia's low-cost suppliers, natural gas prices tend to fluctuate over time in response to supply and demand. Locking in a fixed rate plan for

12 or 24 months helps you avoid drastic swings in energy costs.

The Georgia Agriculture Tax Exemption (GATE) card is issued to farmers and producers who are exempt from state sales tax on the inputs used in the production of their commodity.

To find out what has changed or apply for a GATE card, visit forms.agr.georgia.gov/GATE/

To continue receiving this sales tax exemption from Walton Gas, producers must submit renewed cards to us no later than Jan. 31.
